Dear Parents and Students:

Welcome back to another school year! Registration for students and families Grades 1-12 is on August 29 (4-7 pm). 4K and 5K families should come for pictures, but your registration is September 5th.

On Tuesday, August 29, the following events are planned: (4:00-7:00 p.m.)

- School Pictures. (4K-6 are in the Elementary gym and grades 7-12 are in the High School gym)

- Annual District Report and Schoolwide Title 1 forms/information. **Elementary & MS/HS Offices**
- Orientations- Grade 7 @ **5:15 p.m.** and Grade 9/Foreign Exchange @ **6:00 p.m. Cafeteria**
- Orientation for new students grades 7-12 will be @ **6:00 p.m.** also. **Cafeteria**

Some important changes everyone should be aware of this year.


- The school day runs from 8:00 a.m.- 3:24 p.m. Buses will be running about 10 minutes earlier.
- Universal free breakfast will be provided to all students. MS/HS breakfast is at **7:40 a.m.** and runs until **8:00 a.m.** Grades 7-12 students need to get breakfast ASAP if they want it. If a bus runs late those students will get it when they come to school. (Only exception) Every student who eats breakfast daily must be counted because it allows a reimbursement.
- Free and Reduced forms. (All families should complete.) This gives the district the chance for grants and additional funding that help keep local costs (taxes) down.
- Reduced families will be provided free food services (breakfast and lunch) again this year.
- Free after school food is provided again to traveling teams, organizations, etc.. Stop in office if you have any questions.
- Please keep accounts up-to-date. Things get difficult, so if you need help, please call Mr. Luster at ext 102. We prefer discussing plans/solutions versus making calls seeking payment after reminds go unanswered. Thank you.
