The Smart Boards were purchased through Title 1 ARRA funds, special education ARRA funds, 21st Century technology grants, general education funds, and a gift. Almost everyone that has requested a Smart Board has received one.

Other Technology

Our staff received updated computers in their classrooms this summer through a gift from The Eckstein Foundation and Title 1 funds. We are doing very well in our technology area.

In August the school board hired a business team to help with our technology. *Dependable Solutions* of Prairie du Chien works on the average of 20 hours per week to assist with our technology needs. Alisa Oswald, our business teacher, is also on-site to assist with technology solutions as well.

We have added computers and software in our technical education classroom for *CADD II*. We have also purchased new software for a student who is taking *Computer-Oriented Art*.

We have three computer labs in our schools. We have a lab in the elementary building, a business lab in the high school, and a mobile lab that can be used by both the elementary or high school.

We also have several iPads (17), iPod Touches (20), and iPod Nanos (12) for student use in the elementary and junior high. We have gone on-line with our *library* and *financial systems* this summer while we are already on-line with our student information system.
